

Cat Supplies

CAT CARRIER IS REQUIRED

This is what I have been feeding your baby!!

At least three feeding dishes for:

- 1) Hard food
- 2) Wet food
- 3) Water (stainless steel is ideal)

Litter box Recommended to have one for each cat. Be sure to get a bigger box for larger cats. Stainless steel litter boxes are the new trend, easier to clean & don't hold the smell. (Seems to be the cheapest on Amazon)



Consumables: Unscented litter. Cats can smell 14x better than humans. **No Scented Litter!**

Hard Food: Kitten Royal Canin either Mother & BabyCat or Kitten, Adults Nulo hard food.

Wet Food:

For Kittens: Tiki Baby Cat, Fancy Feast & put Applaws tuna or Weruuva chicken on top.

On top fancy feast with Wuvera Chicken or Applaws Tuna (or Pumpkin), picture below.



Adult cats: I feed gravy fancy feast and top with Wuvera Chicken & Applaws tuna.



Your cat will tell you what they don't like by not eating it. Also, their taste buds change, so you might have to change food at some point. Better quality food will keep your cat healthier.

If you're kitten/ cat has soft stool (diarrhea) try food with pumpkin. If diarrhea persist take your cat to the Vet. With our community litters it's hard to tell if a cat has diarrhea.
